

Proceeding with order and payments. (Australia only)

Short summary

- Order item/s and Pay in USD to Aquatooth Limited, sent to your nearest port.
- Pay Australian based Customs Brokers [directly in AUD] Sea Freight, Customs, GST and other local charges such as cartage etc.
- Receive goods ordered

Details

Click on 'Add to order' at base of page.

Go to the left near the top and click on 'show order'

it will then show the amount payable in USD for the products only.

Click on >>Continue order

Fill out the customer information for delivery/billing.

Please make sure that phone numbers and address is accurate as these will be used for shipping. Do not use PO Boxes (these are too small to fit your order into!)

Click on box to agree

click on 'send registration'

Write any additional information or instructions, such as 'Urgent'

Click on box to agree

It will then say 'your order has been successfully placed'

Check your email for receipt of order.

We will manually respond by email with a 'Sales Contract' we ask to be signed and returned by email/scan or by fax.

Also included will be our banking information so you can make payment by telegraphic transfer to our account at HSBC Hong Kong. We suggest you use OFX as many of our customers in Australia do because it reduces banking fees and the exchange rates are guaranteed by them to be better than the banks. [Click here for; OFX special offer refer a friend get \\$50 iTunes voucher](#) It may take 2-3 days to set up an account with OFX.

When confirmation of funds has occurred [usually 20 minutes to 3 days] we process your order, inform you by email, and make arrangements for shipping etc.

Our Australian based Customs Broker can confirm the estimated pricing for your order. For the following:

- Customs clearance and other local charges
- Stamp Duty and GST
- Sea Freight from Shanghai [or other port in China]
- Cartage/ warehouse pickup OR cartage to your location.

Final pricing is calculated and becomes payable to the customs broker directly, after the order is shipped, but before arrival at port. This is done to avoid any delay which would cost extra.
